Accidents and near misses

If you are involved in, or witness an accident or near miss while on-site, please report it to the Helmore Building Reception desk immediately.

Arrivals

On arrival, please head to the door you are directed to by event staff. Please have your ticket ready for inspection. If you don't have a ticket on arrival, please report to the registration desk at Helmore building.

Your exhibition ticket is personal to you and should not be passed on to other group members as this would compromise the security of your data.

To comply with data protection regulations, it's essential that individuals at our exhibitions use their own ticket – both on entering, and when visiting exhibitors stands. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be asked to leave the event and re-register to gain re-admittance.

If you are arriving by coach, arrival details will be sent separately to the school representative.

C

Cars

During the exhibition, the best places to park are [Queen Anne Car Park](#) (postcode CB1 1ND) or [The Grafton Centre](#) (postcode CB1 1PS).

Catering

Coaches

Coach drop-off and pick up is only available if you have informed UCAS you will be bringing a coach at the time you made your booking. Schools will be sent arrival details approximately 2 weeks before the event: please read these carefully as our city-centre location means that we have a very limited number of spaces available. Directions

The postcode for the event is CB1 1PT. Our campus is approximately 20 minutes from the rail station on foot. Please head to the reception of the Helmore Building (glass-fronted) when you arrive.
